
Walkable Main Street Village Business Assn.

This is a community soup stone project whereby all and any residents of Garland contribute their ideas and "two bits" for making Walkable Main and the surrounding Walkable Main Village more a sustainable and happy place to live and do business. However, in regard to the businesses listed in this document, it is expected that the owner/renters of these businesses and properties will have the overriding input in guiding the development of these changes that impact their sites. The same can be said for the residents who currently have their homes in this mixed-use neighborhood. Overview

This section, like all sections of this proposal is a working document. Its purpose is to get people talking and planning about how to move forward in the creation of a viable, mixed-used neighborhood in the area defined in previous documents related to this project as "Walkable Main Street Village."

It is suggested that all the businesses currently located in this area form an association known as the "Walkable Main Street Village Business Association. Please note that the list of businesses may not be complete. We have listed those that we have observed. If you look at the map on the cover page to this document, you can see in the grayed areas locations of the various buildings in this area. There may be more in this area. - 26. Advanced Auto Parts [Corner, south side Main, First Street entrance]

Materials

Materials needed would depend on the determination of the re-design plan for this space.

Resources

Again, the resources needed for the re-design efforts for each space would be determined by the plan.

However it is expected that most of the resources for the redesign of this space would come from community donations, foundation grants, and volunteer labor.

Note: The entire project of WALKABLE MAIN is a Soup Stone community involvement project whereby all participants bring "vegetables" to make the "soup." We are working together to make our community more inviting, unique and lovable and in so doing, we are lifting up the quality of our own lives and our local economy. We are all connected and it is to all our best interests to enhance that connectivity.

Enhancing Walkable Connections to downtown and to other areas within the Main Street Walkable Village.

Signage with Walkable information will be located throughout the Main Street Walkable Village. "Walk 7 minutes to The Generator for a good cup of coffee". "From here only a 10 minute walk to Rose Detail for the cleanest car you ever had—be sure and bring your car even if you are walking." These signs would be funny yet functional and would provide accurate maps for walkers to the place of business. The timing for the walk and distances in mile percentages would be accurate too. Downtown can have signs directing to Walkable Main and Walkable Main can also have signs with directions to hotspots on the square.
